As part of celebrating February as a Language Activism Month as declared by the Pan South African Language Board (PanSALB), the Centre for Legal Terminology in African Languages (CLTAL), together with the DPW Language Unit have embarked on an ongoing project to produce legal terminology dictionaries in all official languages.

The CLTAL is a committee under the Department of Arts and Culture that is constituted by qualified language practitioners from the public and private sector, tasked with the development of legal terminology that will be used for effective translation and editing of legal documents.

Currently, the committee is working on publishing Sepedi, isiZulu and isiXhosa language dictionaries.

Through such joint initiatives, the DPW Language Unit continues its mission of promoting the use of official languages and is eager to make languages works for you.
