DEPUTY MINISTER SWARTS 'WALKING THE TALK' DURING AN IMBIZO IN THE FREE STATE

Public Works and Infrastructure Deputy Minister Bernice Swarts, together with Free State Public Works and Infrastructure MEC Dibolelo Mance and Maluti-a-Phofung local municipality Mayor Mamotseare Lakaje-Mosia held an imbizo in Kestell in the Free State.

The Imbizo is part of Deputy Minister Swarts' oversight project visits. Before the Imbizo, they first cleaned a local park which has been turned into an illegal dumping site. They then visited a pot-hole fixing project by the Community Works Programme (CWP).

The Deputy Minister also visited the Kestell Magistrate Court which is currently under construction. She addressed a number of concerns raised by subcontractors on site, promising to give updates on a regular basis.
