The CIDB's Best Practice Project Assessment Scheme, otherwise known as the B.U.I.L.D Programme aims to accelerate transformation in construction industry, increase capacity of the construction industry to deliver infrastructure and support the growth of the progra emerging contractors.

"Through the B.U.I.L.D Programme we will address some of the

fundamental stumbling blocks that inhibit the meaningful participation of small and emerging entrepreneurs. Their

potential is often stifled by lack of access to finance and credit, as well as a shortage of opportunities for vocational and management training," said Mr Bongani Dladla, the CEO of CIDB in his opening addressing.

In her address, DPWI Deputy Minister Bernice Swarts said that the B.U.I.L.D Programme will help rebuild the construction sector in an inclusive manner and ensure higher levels of participation by emerging contractors into the major projects that flow from Government's investments in infrastructure. "Through the B.U.I.L.D Programme we will further strengthen the growth of a world-class construction sector that will play a vital role in infrastructure provision in future. Investment in infrastructure is a prominent feature of our economy as we expand services to the people. The Programme will ensure that social development goals are achieved through construction tenders issued by government," explained DM Swarts.
