DPWI DEVELOPS PUBLIC WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE LEGISLATION

Minister Sihle Zikalala and Director-General (DG) Mr Sifiso Mdakane attended the first day of the Technical Workshop for the Public Works and Infrastructure Bill at Garden Court OR Tambo International Airport on 23 January 2024. The 3-day workshop organised by the Policy Research and Regulations Branch - hosted officials from DPWI's regional offices across the country as well as officials from provincial departments within the Public Works and Infrastructure sector.

The workshop aims to develop an over-arching legislation that will capture the mandate of the Public Works and Infrastructure sector. This legislation will give clarity to the provincial

governments and DPWI regional offices about the procedures they need to follow in executing their functions. Some of the stakeholders who will inform the creation of this Public Works Bill include The Presidency, the Forum of South African Directors-General (FOSAD) and the National Economic Development and Labour Council (Nedlac).

In opening the workshop, Minister Zikalala implored colleagues of the DPWI involved in drawing up the Public Works and Infrastructure Bill to be robust and purposeful during the workshop as this bill will be presented to Cabinet and the Portfolio Committee on Public Works and Infrastructure.
