announced by His Excellency President Ramaphosa, in the 2023 State of the Nation Address.

The handover will take place at Ngilanyoni Sports Ground, Ward 7, Mkhambathini Local Municipality, uMgungundlovu District in KwaZulu-Natal.

Welisizwe bridges is a government initiative aimed at addressing the backlog of bridges infrastructure in rural and disadvantaged communities. The construction of Welisizwe Bridges allows for access to health facilities, schools, and economic amenities.

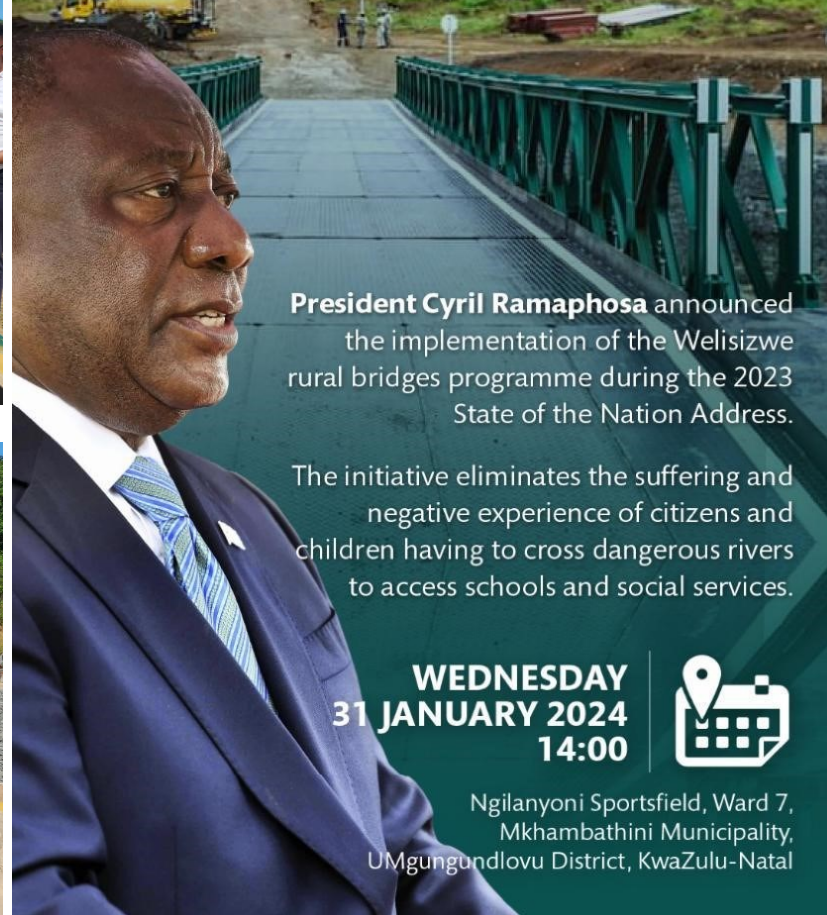
JOHANNESBURG RM TO RETIRE AT THE END OF THIS MONTH
