



Minister Macpherson Opens Cape Town Red Bus Stop at Hout Bay Harbour

The Minister of Public Works and Infrastructure, Dean Macpherson, officially opened the newly established Cape Town Red Bus stop at Hout Bay Harbour. He joined members of the local community to mark this milestone.
