Mpisane feels AFU's pinch

THE high-flying lifestyle of former Durban metro officer, Sibusiso Mpisane, hangs in the balance after the Asset Forfeiture Unit (AFU) yesterday attached his assets to recoup R140m.

Hawks spokesperson Capt Paul Ramaloko confirmed that 15 of his luxury cars worth R25m had been seized during a swoop on his luxury La Lucia house in Durban. The remaining cars, including two top-of-the-range Lamborghinis, could not be located.

The AFU, together with the

Hawks, were executing a court order to recover the assets, viewed as proceeds of a crime.

Mpisane is facing charges of fraud and corruption. He allegedly misrepresented his company, Zikhulise Cleaning and Transport, to the Construction Industry Development Board by submitting fraudulent gradings. The high gradings indicated that the business could handle large construction contracts, which subsequently won the company construction tenders worth R140m.
