Firefighters gear-up for winter season

ABOUT 600 firefighters attached to the Working on Fire (WoF) in the province lave already resumed their duties folowing the long December holidays.

WoF is the Department of Environnental Affairs' expanded public works rogramme. The group of both men and vomen was embarking on a variety of orogrammes as they geared up for the speciming winter fire season.

WoF provincial spokesperson Lebonang Maseko said among other related activities, the team was on the ground with community outreach awareness ampaigns in different areas to educate people about the dangers of fire and how o prevent them from being involved as victims.

Maseko said the WoF team's dedicaion and hard work saw the province ecording a decline in the number of ire cases last year compared with orevious years. "Our firefighters are dready preparing for the 2017 winter ire season. We recorded a significant lrop in the number of fires last year in he province. Building team strength is aking priority because we plan to see drop again this year."
