

# 'Not even Jik will clean JZ'

"The president's image is so tainted not even Jik would clean it," he said.

"If Zuma can reshuffle the cabinet, it's the end of the road for him.

"We will remove Zuma on our own. We are not asking the Constitutional Court to take on our responsibility.

"Let parliament play its role as mandated."

He said they were going to support the DA's motion of no confidence and were confident most ANC members would abstain rather than vote with the ANC.

If more than 80 members abstained there was no way the party could deal with them all,

he said.

"We hope the Constitutional Court will hear

the matter and ultimately instruct parliament to hold some proceedings against President Zuma. Once the process is established by parliament, President Zuma will be called to answer to every little detail," he said.

"That's when South Africans will hear why Zuma made untruthful statements.

"Why is the president never held accountable for the miscon-

duct established by the Constitutional Court?

"The president is not above the law.

"We are asking the Constitutional Court to instruct parliament to do its own constitutional mandate. There is a dispute between us and parliament as to how Zuma should be dealt with."

He said the EFF was not abandoning its responsibility as parliamentarians but that parliament was one of the institutions captured by the Guptas... making parliament meaningless.
