

Summit set to empower women

THE North West provincial government will host a summit for women in the agriculture, culture and tourism sectors on Wednesday at the Mma-batho Convention Centre.

The summit is aimed at producing a programme of action for economic transformation with regard to women in agriculture, culture and tourism.

“It will also focus on multidimensional aspects affecting women in

other key sectors of the provincial economy,” the government said.

The summit is led by the government’s finance, economy and enterprise development, rural, environment and agricultural development, culture, arts and traditional affairs and public works and roads departments.

Women across these sectors of the economy are expected to participate.

Small Business Development Minister Lindiwe Zulu, Mineral Resources Minister Mosebenzi Zwane and Pre-

mier Supra Mahumapelo, as well as former African Union chairperson Dr Nkosazana Dlamini Zuma are expected to speak at the summit.

The provincial government said it was important to bring together dynamic women with regional, national and local experience from across South Africa to engage in vigorous debates and reflections, with the intent to formulate a tangible plan on economic transformation for women.
