- THE DEPUTY Director General of the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP), Stanley Henderson, launched the EPWP development project to support small businesses earlier this week.
- Henderson said that eight out of a total of 27 identified small businesses in the Northern Cape were already receiving assistance through this programme in the form of skills, training, access to start-up capital and the provision of equipment and machinery, to the value of R1 million.
- "Through the Department of Small Business Development, the National Youth Development Agency, training SETAs, municipalities, agricultural partners, provincial and national government assistance will be provided to co-operatives and small businesses to enable them to enter the retail markets," said Henderson.
- He pointed out that the programme was designed to kick-start businesses.
- "Employment should not end once a government project is completed."
