Department embarks on working for the coast tour

Department embarks on working for the coast tour TNA REPORTER THE department of environmental affairs will embark on a tour of the Working for the Coast project at the eastern beach, located next to Ebuhlanti Picnic Park in East London, tomorrow. The tour forms part of the department's campaign aimed at raising awareness about access to the coast and coastal public property and the need to keep such property clean. The programme is one of the department's initiatives aimed at providing job creation, skills development and empowerment of small businesses, while also ensuring cleaning and rehabilitation of the entire South African coastline and the development and maintenance of coastal infrastructure.

In June last year, the department launched the 2016/18 cycle of the Working for the Coast projects worth R30 Om in Durban, for upgrading and maintaining facilities and infrastructure along the coast from Alexander Bay to Kosi Bay, thereby facilitating access to the coastline without compromising the environment. The Ebuhlanti Project is implemented through the department's Environmental Protection and Infrastructure Programme, using labour intensive methods as per the requirements of the expanded public works programme. The media tour will showcase the progress made on the implementation of the projects thus far, given the volumes of beach users and holiday makers expected to increase during the festive season. 701985
