Ex-workers set fire to depot in Tshwane

Exworkers set fire to depot in Tshwane By Penwell Dlamini Angry government workers whose contracts recently expired torched a building in Tshwane yesterday. The Tshwane municipality said, at about Sam, 45 former expanded public works programme workers descended upon its waste management depot in Mabopane, broke down the security gate, and burnt waste bins, an asbestos office and a kitchen. "The former employees have been responsible for ... causing chaos across the city since the beginning of this year," the city said in a statement. "We call upon law enforcement to take action against those vandalising the city's assets and intimidating our employees."
