Help cops find three missing people

POLICE have asked for public help in finding three missing people in the Komani cluster.

Komani police spokeswoman Captain Namhla Mdleleni said the police were looking for Nomfundo Mngwandi, 36, from Cacadu, Avuyile Mbuqe, 28, of Ezibeleni and Asanda Mnyikizo, 30, from Sterkstroom.

Mdleleni said Mngwandi, who is from Hala location in Cacadu and is a general worker at Glen Grey Hospital, had been on leave.

"She was expected to report for duty on Thursday May 10 and she never reported for duty. When the hospital looked at why she did not report for duty, they discovered that she never went home during her leave," he said.

Mdleleni said anyone with knowledge of Mngwandi should call the Cacadu police on (047) 8783-008 or 086-0010-111.

Mdleleni said in another incident, the Ezibeleni police were appealing to residents to assist them in locating Mbuqe.

"He was last seen on May 7 while he was at work at the department of public works.

"He never arrived home from work that day.

"Anyone with information that can assist the police can contact Detective Warrant Officer Zolile Witbooi on (047) 8731-051 or 071-823-9839," she said.

Mdleleni said in the third case, Sterkstroom police were appealing to people from areas between Sterkstroom and East London to help them find Mnyikizo.

"She was last seen on Sunday on her way to East London.

"According to her mother, she phoned her daughter at 6pm on Sunday.

"She could not answer the phone and only responded with a WhatsApp message," Mdleleni said.

She said Mnyikizo in her response to her mother said the people that gave her a lift did not want her to answer her phone.

"After that her phone went offline. Asanda did not reach East London and her phone is on voicemail.

"She was wearing blue jeans, a white T-shirt and maroon leather jacket," he said.
