Enoch Mgijima Local Municipality Mayor Sisisi Tolashe will be delivering her state of the municipality address (SOMA) today, May 31. 'Queenstown Express' correspondent ZINTLE BOBELO asked residents what some of the issues are that they as locals would like to hear addressed?

More tenders should be issued in our municipality, tenders that will only benefit our locals and not outsiders. Also, the issue of our roads and the ageing infrastructure should be addressed.
- Vusumzi Skweyiya: The mayor should address the terrible state of our roads, especially for us motorists. Secondly, the issues of unemployment and drug abuse are currently dominating in our areas. The youth are without jobs. I hope that the mayor will address these challenges.
- Loyiso Ngculu: First, we all know that municipal assets have been impounded. We want to find out what the recovery plan is on getting these assets back.
