

Scopa says braai areas overdone

PARLIAMENT'S Standing Committee on Public Accounts (Scopa) has expressed concern about how the Public Works Department spent about half a million rand on refurbishing braai areas at houses allocated to ministers.

“Scopa is of the view that South Africans cannot be expected to pay that amount of money just for a braai area for a minister,” the committee said Scopa yesterday.
