Expanded Public Works participants receive certificates

KING Cetshwayo District Municipality, in partnership with the Department of Public Works, awarded certificates to 119 participants who completed the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) in Richards Bay last week.

The participants received training in five local municipalities within the district.

EPWP is a nationwide labour absorption programme which provides temporary work for the unemployed.

It consists of projects that employ workers

on a temporary or ongoing basis with government, contractors or other non-governmental organisations.

One of the requirements of the EPWP is that every project implemented must involve training of participants during or at the end of the programme.
