"The Democratic Alliance [DA] in the Western Cape is pleased that thousands of people residing in informal settlements, backyarders and farm workers in Grabouw will now be title deeds recipients."

In a press release issued on 24 October, DA MPP Matlhodi Maseko of the WCPP's Standing Committee on Human Settlements explains that the project began in 2010, "but due to the ANC National Government's incompetence, the hand-over process only took place in December 2017 after the land parcel under the

Department of Public Works was transferred to the DA-led Theewaterskloof municipality."

Maseko said he is proud that under a DA-led Theewaterskloof municipality, 791 beneficiaries have received title deeds to date in Rooidakke.

"In the Slang Park project, 560 houses were built and occupied," he said. "The municipality is currently building at the Hillside project and this application is also with the Department of Public Works."
