New Harbour vandalism

The buildings at the Hermanus New Harbour have suffered vandalism for some time now. On Sunday 11 November people were noticed on the rooftops of one of the buildings, busy stripping off roof plates. According to Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries spokesperson Carol Moses the department was aware that buildings in the harbour had been vandalised, and both the South African Police Services and the Department of Public Works were involved in addressing the matter. The current state of Hermanus' New Harbour has been reported in Hermanus Times ("Chaos at Harbour", 1 November 2018). Hermanus police spokesperson Fadila September said police were aware of vandalism taking place and urged the owners of the building to contact the police immediately when such an incident occurs.
