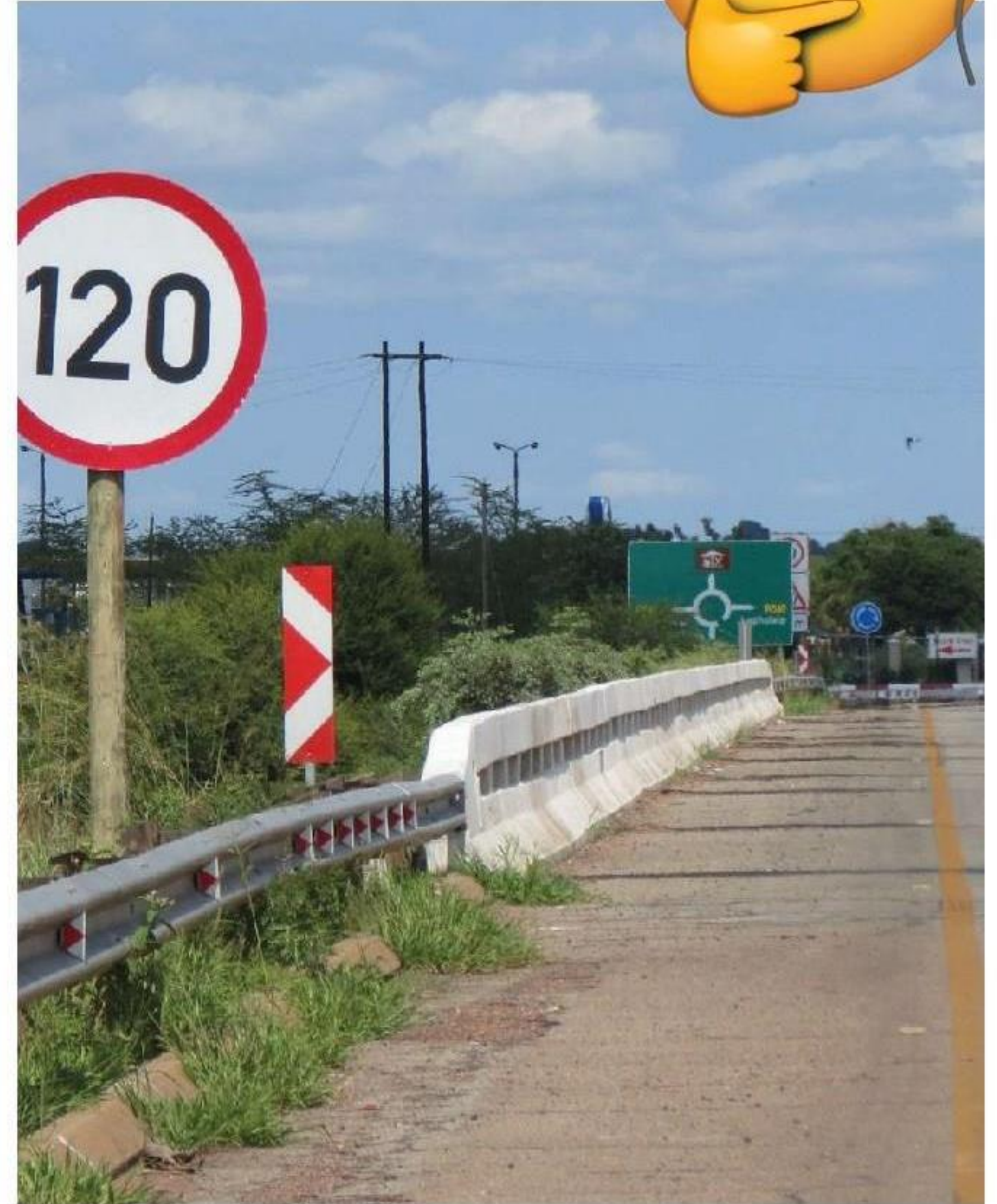


80 km/h to 120 km/h?
