Lentswe, Stilfontein - The case against five men aged between 26 and 66 who appeared in the Stilfontein Magistrates Court on Wednesday mark out stands on the por-7 August for trespassing on a tion of land belonging to Pubproperty belonging to Public lic Works.

Stilfontein police spokesperson Sgt Molly Booysen confirmed that a docket has been opened.

Thembile Botman, a community leader, is not happy about the arrest. "We are not cause we have been behaving,

complying all along. We did not even burn anything for that matter," he said.

"We are so surprised that the municipality is in talks with Public Works, but our people got arrested. It is even taking this light anymore, be- worse that our people are still the women and children wer arrested for trespassing."

Botman said the police only arrested men and no the women and children who were at the scene. Sgt Booy sen said: "The men who wer arrested were found building shacks on the property and just standing in the street."
