SERVICE-DELIVERY confidence was instilled in the Dududu community when the municipality officially opened the Dududu Satellite Offices aimed at creating an enabling environment for this community to participate actively in the affairs of the municipality on Monday.

The offices have been closed since the amalgamation of the erstwhile Vulamehlo and Umdoni municipalities in 2016, and their reopening follows after the municipality identified a gap of limited access to the municipality by the Dududu community and surrounding areas, thus reviving them to bring services closer to the people.

We are proud to announce that these offices will operate on a full-time basis from Monday to Friday from 7.30 am to 4 pm

And the community will have access to services which include housing, road maintenance, waste management, Extended Public Works Programme (EPWP), traffic, fire and disaster, Local Economic Develop-
