## Angry workers target city hall over grievances

Mxolisi Nyuswa, chairperson of the MK Vets in the eThekwini region, expressed shock and said he could not comment as he had not heard about the incident. He would investigate the matter today to get more information.

EThekwini municipality has over the years had to deal with several incidents where offices were stormed by people wanting officials to deal with their grievances. Last October, the Daily News reported that Expanded Public Works Programme workers had stormed city hall, demanding to know why their wages had not been paid. Security at city hall was beefed up soon after, making it difficult for the offices to be stormed.

The Mercury reported that former members of the Azanian People's Liberation Army (Apla) stormed the city hall in 2016 because they were not being given job opportunities.
