R15m paid to house Zondo commission

PUBLIC WORKS and Infrastructure Minister Patricia de Lille has revealed that R14.8 million has been paid to a media company and property group for the housing of the Zondo commission of inquiry.

De Lille revealed this in a written response to a parliamentary question posed by EFF MP Mgcini Tshwaku, who quizzed De Lille on contracts signed with the companies as well as the duration of the contracts and amounts paid to date.

In a written response, De Lille said up to R1.2m was paid monthly towards rental costs of offices as well as the auditorium from Tiso Blackstar and Redefine Properties.

“The total amount paid to date is R14 837 975.97,” she said.
