## BETWEEN 150 000 and 200 000

25 years ago

people have been forcibly removed from the Northern Cape and resettled in the "homelands" since 1960. At least another 25 000 blacks face resettlement in the future. Most of the relocation in the Northern Cape took place in the early '70s, making this the most thoroughly cleaned area in South Africa.
