After visiting the Mokoena and Sibisi families in Sinathing, the MEC undertook to assist with the provision of two TRUs to the two families. The two TRUs were speedily constructed and completed in time for Mahlaba to hand them over on October 14.2022.

At the beginning of October, the department also handed over a Operation Sukuma Sakhe dusabled friendly house to Mi-chael Basi of KwaMazakhele, on the outskirts of Harding town in uMuziwabantu Local Municipality. The elated 52-year-old could not hide his happiness when MEC for Social De-velopment, Nonhanhal KARoza, on behalf of MEC Mahlaba, officiated the house handover together with municipal lead-ership.
