Road construction project reaches completion

The Limpopo MEC for Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure, Nkakareng Rakgoale, has reassured the community that the department remains determined to ensure that the existing paved road network in the province is fully maintained.

The MEC's reassurance follows the recent preventative maintenance of road D1392 in Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality. Its completion has brought a sigh of relief to residents in Ga-Malekane and Ga-Mampuru villages outside Steelpoort.

Road D1392 traverses through a mountainous area and plays a vital role in connecting the two villages. It was in a state of disrepair, causing significant

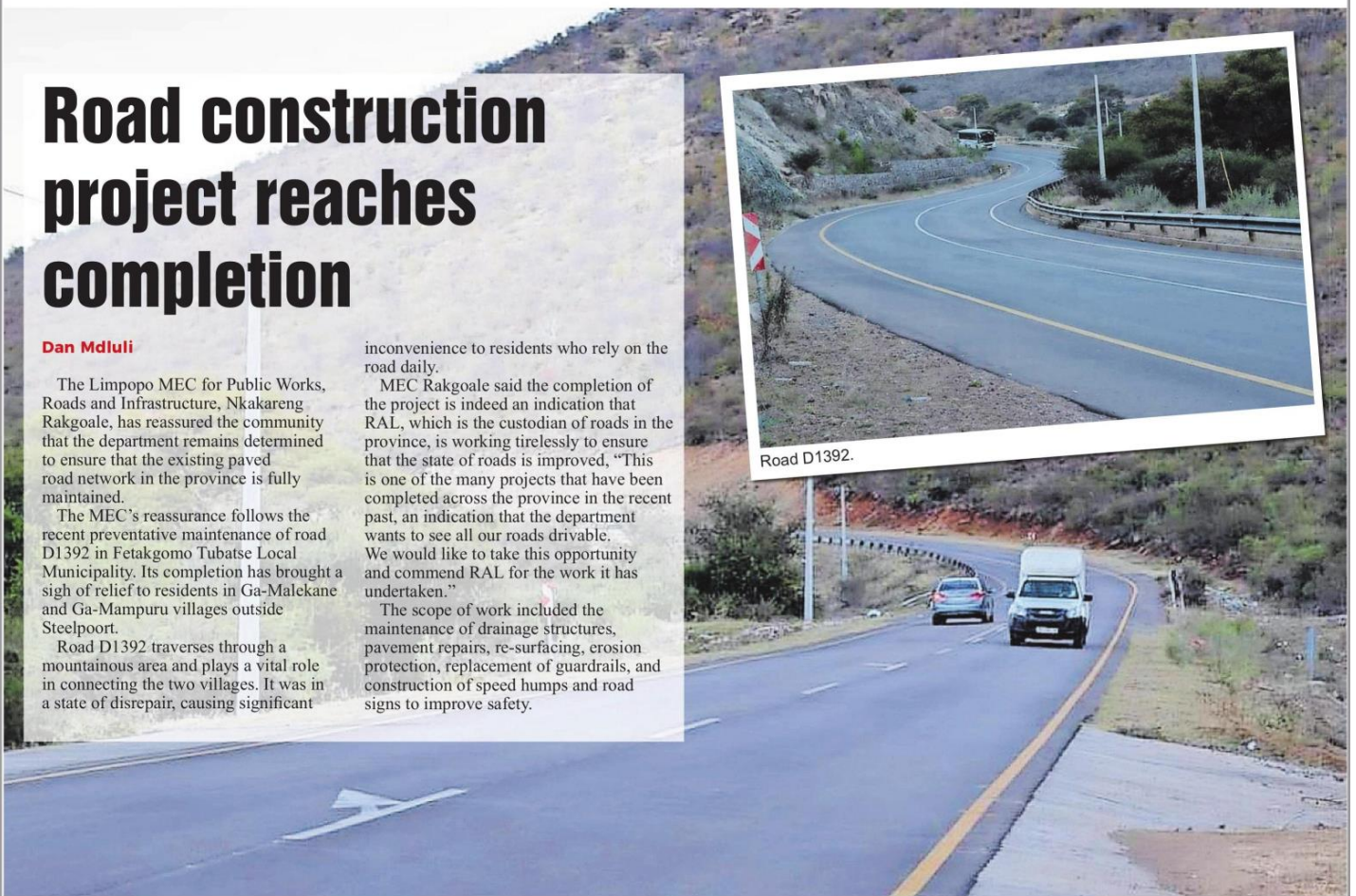
inconvenience to residents who rely on the road daily.

MEC Rakgoale said the completion of the project is indeed an indication that RAL, which is the custodian of roads in the province, is working tirelessly to ensure that the state of roads is improved. "This is one of the many projects that have been completed across the province in the recent past, an indication that the department wants to see all our roads drivable. We would like to take this opportunity and commend RAL for the work it has undertaken."

The scope of work included the maintenance of drainage structures, pavement repairs, re-surfacing, erosion protection, replacement of guardrails, and construction of speed humps and road signs to improve safety.
