Thuntsha Lerole programme launched to accelerate service delivery

MAHIKENG MAIL-MAHIKENG: Ipelegeng Township in Schweizer Reneke, Mamusa Local Municipality, were hived of activity last week Friday during the official launch of 'Thuntsha Lerole' programme by the North West Province acting Premier, Patrick Dumile Nono Maloyi which aims to accelerated service delivery in the North West province.

The primary objective of the initiative was to mobilise communities to be part of a solution in addressing service delivery challenges confronting the province and creating a platform for constant feedback from communities about the progress registered by government in responding to the demands of basic services in the province.

The programme is focused clearing of illegal dumping sites, fixing of internal roads, patching of potholes, demonstrations by Veterinarians to local farmers, handing over of agricultural produce to identified families, registration of SMMEs, online application

services and handing over of mobile library buses to qualifying areas.

The Acting Premier was joined by Political Heads and Departmental Officials from Health, public Works and Roads; Education and Social Development.

The Acting Premier Maloyi was seen participating in various service delivery activities of patching of potholes and refuse collection including handing over title deeds as well as inspecting bulk water project in the area. He also engaged with community members on some of the challenges confronting the community.
