Five properties meant for GBV shelters in Gauteng, handed over in December 2019 by the former minister of the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure (DPWI). Instead of providing security in the form of shelters for victims of GBV, DPWI has spent more than R11 million from January 2019 to September 30, 2023 on security personnel safeguarding closed properties in Gauteng.
