MOA to rehabilitate several roads signed

The MEC for Limpopo Department of Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure Mme Nkakareng Rakgoale together with COGTA Deputy Minister Parks Tau, MEC for Public Works, Roads, and Treasury MEC Seaparo Sekoati, as well as Mayors from twelve municipalities, recently attended a briefing session just before the signing of the Memorandum of Agreements with Roads Agency Limpopo at a venue outside Polokwane.

The twelve local municipalities that have benefited from the MoA include Polokwane, Thabazimbi, Collins Chabane, Fetakgomo-Tubatse, Elias Motsoaledi, Bela-Bela, Musina, Ba-Phalaborwa, Modimolle–Mookgophong, Ephraim Mogale, Mogalakwena, and Makhado. This partnership aims to enhance daily travel for Limpopo citizens, promote tourism, and drive economic growth amongst others.

Meanwhile, Roads Agency Limpopo said the signing of the MOA is part of the agency's municipal intervention with the aim of rehabilitating and maintaining municipal roads. "Today's [Friday 6 October] municipal MoA signing marks a significant milestone, enabling RAL to extend vital road construction skills to all 22 local municipalities in the province. This initiative aims to restore roads in towns and residential areas, ensuring safer and faster driving experiences for citizens," Roads Agency Limpopo added.
