The Limpopo MEC for Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure, Ms Nkakareng Rakgoale, and Economic Development, Environment and Tourism MEC Rodgers Monama, visited a service delivery project on Monday at Ga-Malekane Village ahead of the Presidential Imbizo scheduled at Ga-Motodi Village outside Burgersfort.

The two MECs were joined by councillors and checked on the progress of the new bridge next to the large steel bridge.

MEC Rakgoale expressed her delight at the commencement of the construction and how the completion will bring improved traffic flow to the area. The project is being constructed jointly with eight mining houses operating in the Steelpoort mining area. Rakhoma Mining Resources, Dwarsrivier Chrome Mine, Glencore, Rustenburg Platinum, Samancor Chrome, Booyendal Platinum, Tjate Platinum and Two Rivers Platinum all collaborated on the steel bridge construction project.

The project is taking place on road D2219 joining the R555 Steelpoort mining town, and despite facing several challenges, such as delays related to work permits and
