Department Of Public Works and Infrastructure MEC Ntombovuyo Nkopane to Officially Hand Over Ntsizwa SSS TO DoE

DPWI MEC is set to officially handover Ntsizwa Senior Secondary School to the Department of Education.

The Alfred Nzo District project, valued at over R 39 million, was construction of 28 classrooms, a guardhouse, dining and nutrition centre, a library, laboratory, ablution blocks, walkways and parking area. The construction of the school made use of local labour consisting of 30 men and 13 women, as well as local SMMEs to the total of R 8.8 million and EPWP trainees.

The single storey building is also fitted with disability friendly facilities such as a ramp, parking, signage and toilets for the disabled.

Before the renovation, Ntsizwa SSS was a mud structure. As part of her visit to the Alfred Nzo Region, the MEC will be paying a meet and greet visit to the eMaXesibeni Traditional Council, under Chief Gcinuhlanga Jojo in Umzimvubu Local Municipality. The visit comes as a fulfilment of a commitment made by the HON MEC, to engage indigenous leadership as part of her Stakeholder Engagement sessions.
