Medfontein building closed

The Free State Department of Community Safety, Roads and Transport (CSRT) announced the closure of the Medfontein building where some of their directorates are based on 12 May. CSRT Spokesperson Hilary Mophethe said the building was closed by the Department of Labour due to electrical wiring non-compliance. The CSRT is awaiting a detailed report on this matter from the Department of Labour.

The building is located in St. Andrew Street opposite OR Tambo House/Lebohang Building.

License applications, license

renewals, renewal of expired discs, change of ownership and other license-related services can be done at Dikela House, corner St. Andrews and Aliwal Street.

The estimated period of closure is about 30 days.

The DA's Member of the Provincial Legislature (MPL) Jafta Mokoena said his party has urged the Department of Transport and the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure to investigate the faults that led to the closure of the Medfontein building in Bloemfontein.
