The family received a new home after KZN MEC for Human Settlements and Public Works Siphon Nkosi visited Umuziwabantu Municipality on Tuesday this week, with Operation Siyahhlola.

Nkosi had been in the area to inspect three rural housing projects in Umuziwabantu Municipality.

During Operation Siyahhlola, the MEC was accompanied by the appointed contractor who

promised to complete a house in six weeks for a pensioner whose mud house was destroyed by heavy rains.
