Originally set to open in February, the Public Works and Infrastructure department has pushed out the new deadline to November.

The current Home Affairs office on Hulett Street, located in Global House, has long been a bone of contention for residents. The building's long staircase is a significant challenge for the elderly and the disabled and there are no toilets on site.
