## Magongo removed from fleet management role

After unions and workers stormed City Hall three weeks ago demanding that Zukile Magongo be removed as acting fleet management director, Nelson Mandela Bay roads and transport boss Yusuf Gaffore has done so.

port employees," he said. Earlier in June, about 100 workers stormed City Hall to demand Magongo be removed because his decisions had allegedly crippled the division.

The protesters alleged Magongo had left long-stand-ing vacancies at the division unfilled, failed to pay service providers and abused the Expanded Public Works Pengrapmen

Programme. Magongo has returned to his position as manager of monitoring and acquisitions at

the fleet management division. An official has yet to be ap-pointed to act as fleet manage-

ment director.
