achieve infrastructure-led economic growth. Their discussions will range from strengthening industry capacity and skills to prioritising local procurement and ensuring collaboration across government, business and community stakeholders.

The SA National Roads Agency (SANRAL) will lead the discussion on public-private partnerships, focusing on unlocking investment and delivery at scale, while the Construction Education and Training Authority (CETA) will be spotlighted for its role in developing the skills pipeline critical to the country's infrastructure ambitions.
