ARD 120 Councillor Puseletso Nzimande has responded to concerns from the Lenasia South community regarding the adjustment budget, repairs to potholes and streetlights, grass cutting, enforcement of by-laws, removal of illegal advertising, cleaning up of illegal dumping, and the fining of perpetrators, providing the following update:
With regards to illegal dumping, the Department of Economic Development has employed 10 Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) workers that are cleaning every day. A ward committee member



for Department of Environment & Infrastructure Services (EISD), has

Potholes on other streets have been attended to; however, the community must report and log incidents and provide reference as proof of reporting. Street lights were repaired; however, residents vandalised them, and they don't take care of their infrastructure. Also, a contractor is allocated to start repairing those street lights again. Last week, they were busy with assessing the streets that were allocated by my office.
