Police members joined an initiative to patch potholes on the R566.

The police in the Brits surrounding areas went above and beyond their duty to protect last week and joined an initiative to patch potholes on the R566.

Police members from Mooinooi and Bethanie, led by their station commanders and in conjunction with Bila Civils, the chairperson of Mooinooi Rural Safety Forum, Mooinooi and Bethanie Community Police Forums (CPsF) and the provincial Department of Public Works and Infrastructure (DPWI), patched potholes on the R566 road between Majakaneng taxi rank and Berseba village," said police spokesperson Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone.
