Contractors announced for road upgrades

The much-awaited upgrading of roads from gravel to tar, the D4230 in Leolo and D4328 in Mohlalaotoane villages, in Makhuduthamaga and Ephraim Mogale local municipalities, are expected to begin soon.

The Limpopo MEC for Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure, Ernest Rachoene, introduced the contractors responsible for the projects to communities last week.

Rachoene introduced TCT Civils and Construction for the first phase of the work

on the D4230 access road.

The Bothlabatsatsi Group was announced as the contractor to implement the upgrades from Mohlalaotoane to Sereting Village, which easily connects to Marble Hall, and Phokwane to Jane Furse.

Rachoene said the introduction of the contractors is a demonstration that the seventh administration is determined to serve communities. The MEC called on communities to work with the department to ensure that construction projects are completed without disruptions.

Speaking at Leolo, Rachoene highlighted that the government has brought a huge opportunity to the community through the project, considering the need for road upgrades across the province.

“Therefore, the project must not fail. If we happen to experience disruptions by some community groups, we won’t hesitate to take the project elsewhere, because this service is much-needed,” Rachoene cautioned. He further urged the contractors to deliver within the budget and ensure quality and integrity in their work.
