Rollout of satellite offices

Mayor Minah Bahula's undertaking to establish Sekhukhune District Municipality Executive Mayor's satellite offices across the four local municipalities began last Thursday.

The first office was launched in Jane Furse at the Kgaola Mafiri Building in Makhuduthamaga Local Municipality. Lemson Moropjane said the initiative aims to bring government services closer to communities, improving accessibility.

Moropjane indicated that, given the size and diversity of Makhuduthamaga, two satellite offices will be developed in the sub-region, with another at Makgwabe Community Hall to serve the Masemola cluster, while the Kgaola Mafiri office assists Jane Furse.

MMC's Matabane Mathale and Kanana Leokana will head the establishments.

"The offices will function as political and high-level administrative support centres, strengthening intervention and co-ordination in service delivery across the district," stated Moropjane.

The executive mayor pointed out that in the interim, the Extended Public Works Programme will be engaged to support and monitor activities at the new offices. She elaborated that their role will be to serve as a vital link between the community and the mayor's office, without disrupting the normal provision of municipal services.

Bahula further thanked Makhuduthamaga Local Municipality Mayor Merah Mahlase and Council Speaker Judy Nkgadima for the support and assistance provided in the initiative. Another satellite office was opened in Ga-Nkoana in Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality last Friday.
