New Middelburg Hospital nearing its completion, says public works

MIDDELBURG - The MEC for health, Sasekani Manzini, and MEC for public works, roads and transport, Thulasizwe Thomo, visited the new Middelburg District Hospital in the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on Wednesday, February 12, as part of the project management assessment programme currently under way across the province.

According to public works, the hospital is an achievement that showcases its dedication to delivering quality mega-infrastructure initiatives.
