## PSA urges suspension of IDT officials over oxygen plant tender

The Public Servants Association (PSA) has called for the immediate suspension of Inde-pendent Development Trust (IDT) officials implicated in alleged misconduct in the R800m oxygen plant tender, pending the outcome of investigations.

The PSA said it was outraged by revelations of alleged fraud and gross mismanagement in the R836m pressure swing ad-

sorption oxygen plant project, overseen by the IDT. Public works and infrastruc-ture minister Dean Macpherson released the findings of an independent forensic investiga-tion on Tuesday. The investigation recommended disciplinary action against IDT CEO Tebogo Malaka, GM for supply chain management Molebedi Sisi and other offi-
