SOUTH AFRICA CLOSES LAND PORTS OF ENTRY AS PART OF COVID 19 RESTRICTIONS

On the 27th of June 2021, the President of the Republic of South Africa, His Excellency, President Cyril Ramaphosa addressed the nation on the response of government to the surge in coronavirus (COVID-19) cases and the related third wave gripping the country. In his address, the President informed the public of the Special Cabinet decision to move the country back to lockdown adjusted alert level 4 which was effective from the 28th of June 2021.

In line with the executive decision of the President, the Minister of Home Affairs published directives in terms of Disaster Management legislation to prevent and combat the spread of COVID-19. These directions contain the decision to close 33 of South Africa’s 54 Land Ports of Entry (51 of which the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure is the custodian); to contain the spread of the coronavirus through movements into and out of the country during this phase of the lockdown.
