### **SUSTAINABLE INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT SYMPOSIUM TO RECEIVE KEYNOTE ADDRESS FROM H.E PRESIDENT CYRIL RAMAPHOSA**

Today, 27 May 2025, H.E President Cyril Ramaphosa will deliver the keynote address at the Sustainable Infrastructure Development Symposium South Africa 2025 in Century City, Cape Town. President Ramaphosa inaugurated this Symposium in 2020 after calling for a robust infrastructure investment Programme to support the Country's economic growth ambitions.

This morning the opening plenary of the Symposium will also:

1. Unveil the second edition of the Construction book

**This** edition of the construction book includes over 180 projects, with a total estimated value exceeding R268 billion. It is Infrastructure South Africa's goal that the Construction Book becomes the go-to source of reliable, up-to-date information on construction projects that are fully funded and ready for procurement. This aligns with our broader mission to promote a predictable, transparent, and investable infrastructure environment to further build trust in the industry and attract additional investment.

2. Announce the Top 7 Infrastructure Project Priorities for Project Preparation

These projects are selected from the Bid Window 1 on Project Preparation where Infrastructure South Africa called on the submission of projects that have potential to unlock significant economic opportunities.

3. Signing of 2 MOU's

Infrastructure South Africa Will sign two MOU's with Meridiam SAS and Huawei Technologies to advance critical work that will advance Infrastructure Development.
