PUBLIC WORKS & INFRASTRUCTURE MINISTER MACPHERSON TO HAND OVER THREE WELISIZWE BRIDGES IN KWAZULU-NATAL

The Minister of Public Works & Infrastructure, Dean Macpherson, will, on Wednesday, 6 November 2024, hand over three Welisizwe rural bridges in Umzinyathi, Inanda, KwaZulu-Natal, to benefit the community. He will be joined by the KwaZulu-Natal Member of the Executive Council (MEC) for Public Works & Infrastructure, Martin Meyer, and the Mayor of eThekweni Metropolitan Municipality, Cyril Xaba.

Through the Welisizwe Rural Bridge Programme, the Department of Public Works & Infrastructure aims to construct 96 bridges in rural communities each year, working in collaboration with the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) to connect communities to schools, hospitals, and other essential services.
