

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR GROOTE SCHUUR HOUSE/MUSEUM INSURANCE FOR MOVABLE ASSETS (HERITAGE COLLECTION)

1. OBJECTIVE

The Department of Public Works and Infrastructure (DPWI) invites bids for the appointment of an Insurance Broker or Insurance Company to insure the movable assets (heritage collection) at Groote Schuur House/Museum for a short term period of one year. The insurance should cover the movable assets (Heritage Collection) on all risks basis (e.g. fire /peril/accidental loss and damage). It must be noted that the Groote Schuur House at present is not used as a residence but as the museum although it is not officially declared as a museum. The collection was declared Cultural Treasure.

2. DELIVERABLES AND TASKS

The House Contents Movable Assets (Heritage Collection): The contents of Groote Schuur House consist of two collections - Rhodes and the Groote Schuur Collection which includes items from the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure.

The Rhodes collection consists of antique items many of which have been declared by SAHRA and includes furniture, artwork, tapestries, metal, ceramics, books and maps.

The Groote Schuur House Collection consists of similar items but includes newer pieces while the DPW consists of more functional and everyday items.

Itemized full report of individual items which include replacement cost is available for viewing.

The Heritage Collection is divided in to 5 Categories:

- **1. ARTWORK 210**
- 2. METAL 557 plus 22 WEAPONS
- 3. HERITAGE AND OTHER FURNITURE 358
- 4. CERAMIC 508 & GLASS WARE 88
- 5. BOOKS 3100

GROOTE SCHUUR HOUSE/MUSEUM

All the mentioned items are kept at this house. There are also unique features in the house, such as the Spanish leather panels from the 17th century on the walls of the drawing rooms and copies in wood of the Zimbabwe Bird on the bannisters of the main staircase. All the paneling, doors and floors are made in Burmese teak which is now an endangered species and which can only be replaced at considerable cost. The house has 35 rooms (not all furnished) and four lobbies.

3. CONTRACTUAL ASPECTS

- 3.1 The contents of this document shall be deemed to constitute the Special Conditions of Contract applicable to this bid, and shall be read together with the General Conditions (PA10) of the Contract issued in accordance with Chapter 16A of the Treasury Regulations.
- 3.2 Where, however, the Special Conditions of contract are in conflict with General Conditions of Contract, the Special Conditions of Contract shall prevail.
- 3.3 The bid document, together with the specifications contained in this document, shall constitute part of the Contract.
- 3.4 Bidders shall not perform any work or render any services in terms of the Contract unless in receipt of a written instruction to this effect by the Department.

HERITAGE AND OTHER FURNITURE - 358

15 armoires, 4 desks, 7 long case clocks, 1 exceptional chest, 7 kists, 34 pieces in teak and other exotic woods designed for the verandas, as well as beds, washstands and tables designed by Herbert Baker, Other heritage items are the Dolmetch piano and the tables on which the Groote Schuur Minute was signed.. Included in furniture are carpets and rugs and fitted items such as the chandeliers and

fixed cupboards, as well as items from Tuynhuys (table, 18 chairs, 2 benches and a carpet) and Highstead (4 cupboards).

CERAMICS 508 and GLASS 88

Ceramic collection largely oriental and Dutch. Many are damaged but must still be valued as part of the declared collection

BOOKS - 3100 individual volumes

Most books were published in the late 19th century but there are also ones dating to previous centuries and first editions (such as, Kolbe's Naaukerige *Beschryving van de Kaap de Goede Hoop* CXXVIL). Important are the 444 translations into English of classical texts; the three volumes of original woodcut, engraved and hand drawn maps; as well as later additions.

Single volumes number over 3100, yet many from parts of sets, for example, Cicero's *Orations* - 8 volumes, Ovid - 17, *Records of the Cape Colony* - 8. There are number of sets of encyclopaedias and dictionaries.
