APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER TO DELIVER ON THE CERTIFIED WATER EFFECIENCY PROFESSIONAL (CWEP) COURSE

1. Purpose

The Directorate: Human Resources Development requires the appointment of accredited and credible service provider to deliver Certified Water Efficiency Professional (CWEP) course.
