

2. Background

The Department of Public Works has in line with the Skills Development Act and Human Resources Development Strategy conducted a training needs analysis for the current financial year and approved a Training Plan for implementation of needs.

3. Expected Outcomes/ Deliverables

The overall objectives of the workshop are as follows :

- Structure, draft and write clear and concrete technical reports;
- Present technical information and findings that are supported by well-researched facts and figures;
- Support source of information and analyse such information so that it makes perfect sense to the reader;
- Use the 'tricks of the trade' in terms of graphs and how to make them work for you and your report;
- Troubleshoot common technical report writing mistakes & problems – learn how to avoid the typical pitfalls;
- Use proven techniques to make sure that every technical report that you write is 100% mistake free;

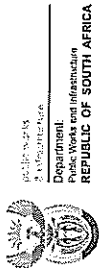

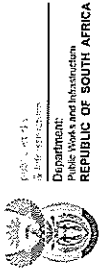

- 3 The Tenderer understands that any intentional misrepresentation or fraudulent information provided herein shall disqualify the Tenderer's offer herein, as well as any other tender offer(s) of the Tenderer simultaneously being evaluated, or will entitle the Employer to cancel any Contract resulting from the Tenderer's offer herein;
- 4 The Tenderer accepts that the Employer may exercise any other remedy it may have in law and in the Contract, including a claim for damages for having to accept a less favourable tender as a result of any such disqualification due to misrepresentation or fraudulent information provided herein;
- 5 Any further documentary proof required by the Employer regarding the information provided herein, will be submitted to the Employer within the time period as may be set by the latter;
