- 1. Fencing must be erected from 04:00 to 06h00 on Friday 02 February 2024 around City Hall. The fencing should be erected along the curb in Darling Street, right next to the City Hall and it should be at least 1.8 meters high.
- 2. The fence must go all along the yellow line on Corporation Street (where taxis park), and should cross Corporation street from the corner of Corporation and Longmarket to the large pillars next to the mutual building, and go down Longmarket Street from Corporation to Parade Street, along the curb of Parade Street back to Darling Street. The crossing in Corporation Street should also be equipped with a gate. Roeland Street and other streets. Fence layout will be provided to the successful service provider.





- (e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

# 4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1,2 and 3 above as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender;
